EDIT LAB UPDATES:

-We have purchased 2 Shure X2u's to be used in this room to cut VO's right at your workstation. You'll find the instructions in the pouch with the unit. If you need further instructions, ask the equipment room staff for help!

Quick Tip: Don't turn the gain up too high or you'll get a lot of noisy room tone in your recording. Before you record please let other edit 1 users know that you'll be recording and ask them for a few minutes of silence.

NEW Equipment 2: -Adobe Premiere users can now ask the equipment room staff to borrow keyboard shortcut skins to help edit.

Internet usage: If going online using the edit 1 computers we want to encourage everyone to use Chrome as the internet browser instead of Safari due to compatibility issues. Safari has been removed from the docks bar but members can still use it if they prefer.

The criteria is as follows:

1. The show must be produced here.

4. The show must air on Channel 10.

The rules are as follows:

1. Only 1 episode per show may be submitted.
2. Staff production producers may submit a show, but the element you want judged cannot be something that you had done by the staff.
